2021 GSSU REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Please Note that:

1. There are no concessional rates for non runners or juniors.
2. Communication to participants is by email only. You do need to quote an accurate email address on your Registration form.

Who are the Victorian Garden Railway Society Inc.?

The Victorian Garden Railway Society is an Incorporated not for profit association made up of the same individuals who have been putting on the GSSU over the past decade.

Remember at the GSSU, we are not in a garden but in an enclosed still air space. Operations do require more attention. The GSSU is not a place for test runs or try outs. Before attending, please ensure your locomotives are in good running condition with safety valves working correctly and no gas or metho fuel leaks.

COVID Matters

Covid Regulations can change at very short notice and it is a condition of your attendance at this event that you will fully comply with all Victorian Government Covid restrictions in force at the time of the GSSU.

At the time of this form's preparation, COVID regulations are:

1. You are required to register by QR Code or manually on arrival on each day of attendance.
2. if current State Government regulations require it, you will have to wear a mask in the Hall.
3. The maximum numbers of people allowed, as displayed for each room must not be exceeded.
4. A distance of 1.5 metres must be kept between attendees at all times.

In the event of Covid restrictions forcing this event to be cancelled, either in full or in part, there will be a full refund for any scheduled days on which the GSSU did not occur.

COVID Restrictions Effect on GSSU Dinner

Currently, the maximum number that can be accommodated in the Resturant is limited to 60. Tighter Covid restrictions could reduce this number further.

Places at the GSSU Dinner will be strictly allocated in order of receipt of payment into the Society's bank account and **bookings for this dinner will not be accepted at the GSSU**. If this event is overbooked, a full refund of unsuccessful applicants Dinner payment will be made.

When Operating

1. All fluid spills, meths, oil and water, **MUST BE CLEANED UP IMMEDIATELY**. If it's your spill, it is your responsibility .
2. Do not 'gas-up' any locomotive on or near the running tracks as the invisible gas overflow pools and is easily ignited by other locomotives in steam nearby.
3. Fill gas tanks preferably outside or well away from any other flame source.
4. Do not block access around the track or access to any exit with boxes or other obstacles
5. Coal fired engines can cause severe respiratory problems running inside (we aren't getting any younger) so please do not run more than one coal fired loco at a time and ensure air quality in the hall is clear before lighting up and that doors and windows open for ventilation. Swapping your coal loco to a suitable running time is easier than calling an Ambulance to a gasping fellow steamer.
